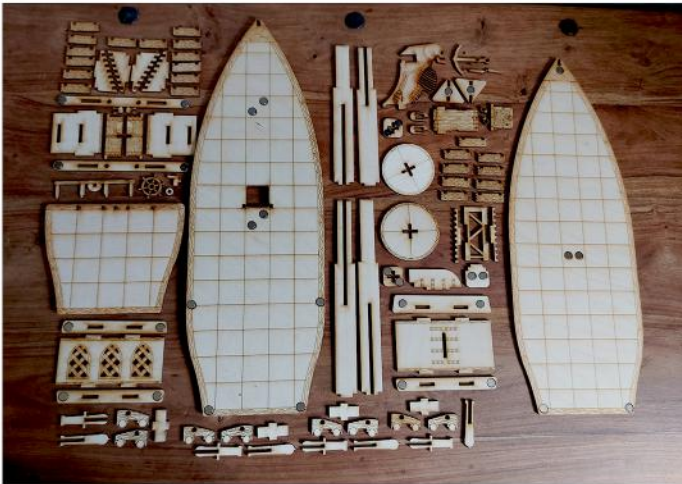




Thank you for purchasing the Level Bedded Pirate Ship.
We recommend using a standard PVA wood glue on this product to ensure a good bond to the wood. Other useful tools to help you assemble your Pirate Ship would be a toothpick or brush to help apply the PVA with and masking tape to help hold it in place whilst it glues up.



Layout all the panel and make sure it includes all parts shown in the Parts List at the back of the instructions. Please note some parts labelled x2 will have different magnet orientations.



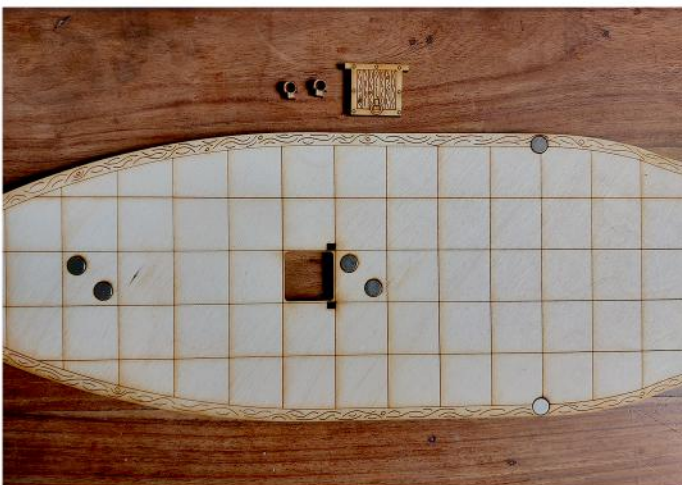
1) Layout the parts for the front of the ship. Check the magnets against the lower deck and underside of the main deck to ensure they are in the correct orientation.



2) Once checked, apply a small amount of glue to the tabs and put them in place with the magnets facing outward as shown above.



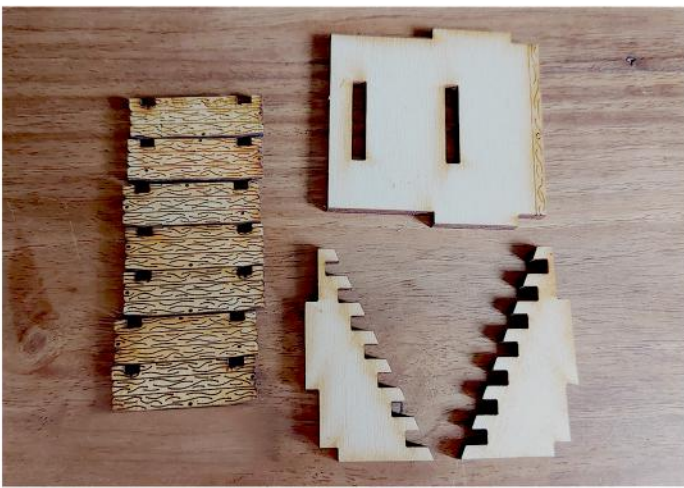
3) The figure head will then be able to magnet into place between the lower deck and main deck as shown above.



4) Layout of the pieces required for the main deck trap doors. x1 Main deck panel, x2 Large hinged doors, x1 Small trap door, x6 hinges. Do not apply any glue to the inner circles of the hinge pieces as this will stop the door opening.



4) Apply a small amount of glue to the square tab on the hinges then place one of them in the holes on the main deck. Then sit the trap door in the round hole and lock in place with the other hinged piece. See image above.



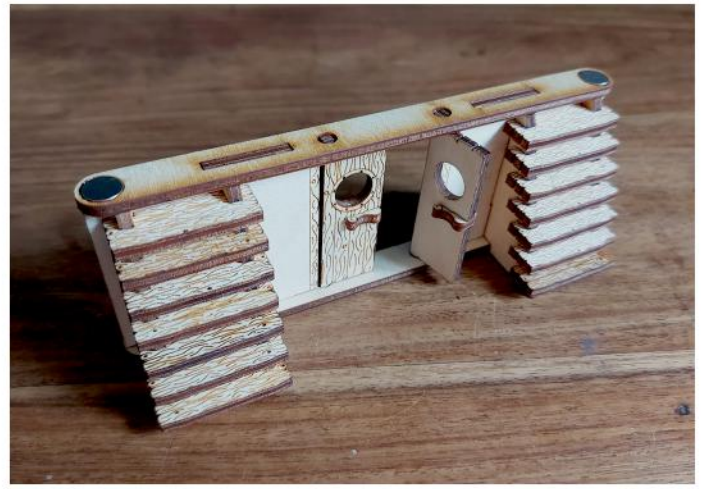
6) Layout of the parts needed to assemble the stairs for the main deck staircase. x1 Wall panel, x2 Stair wall panels, x7 Stair panels.



7) Glue the 2 stair wall panels into the wall panel. Once they are in place, glue the tabs on each of the stairs and lock them into place. Repeat these steps for the other staircase



8) Then, take the x2 door panels and the x2 door handles and apply glue to the inside of the door handle, then put them into place as shown above.



9) Next take the two long magnetic strips and glue them onto the stair wall sections, locking the doors between the two panels using round the holes as shown above. Remember to check the magnetic orientation.



10) Layout of all the parts needed to assemble the window panel. Before gluing the panels into place, make sure you have checked the magnets against the Main deck and Top decks corresponding magnets.



11) Next apply a small amount of glue along the top and bottom window panel tabs. Ensure the magnetic panels are glued with the narrow edge facing the same way as the textured side of the window panel as shown above.

Before gluing any magnetic panel, please ensure you have checked them against their opposite panel to make sure they are the correct orientation and glue facing outward.



12) Layout all the parts needed to assemble the ships helm. Take the small L shaped piece and apply a small amount of glue to the tab which comes out of the longest slide. .



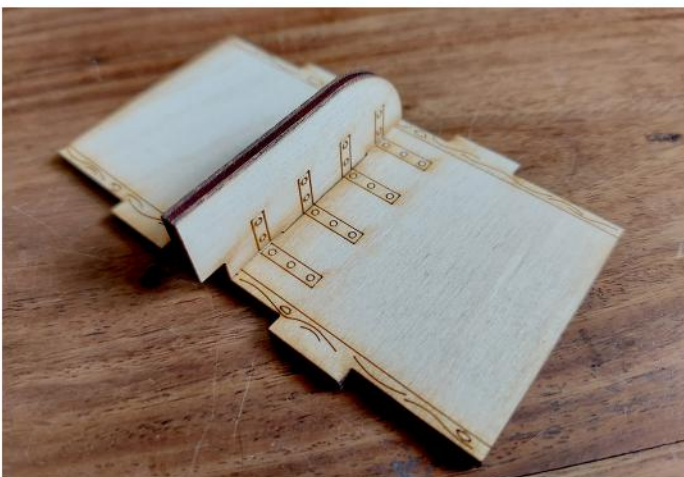
13) Glue in the L shaped piece onto the square hole on the railing and slide the wheel into place (do not glue). Finally, glue the round capping piece in place to stop the wheel coming off.



14) Once the railing is assembled and the wheel is spinning freely, apply glue to the pegs at the bottom of the railings and attach it to the top deck panel as shown above.



15) Layout all parts needed to assemble the rudder wall. x1 Rudder wall panel x1 Rudder panel, x1 wide magnetic panel, x1 magnetic panel.

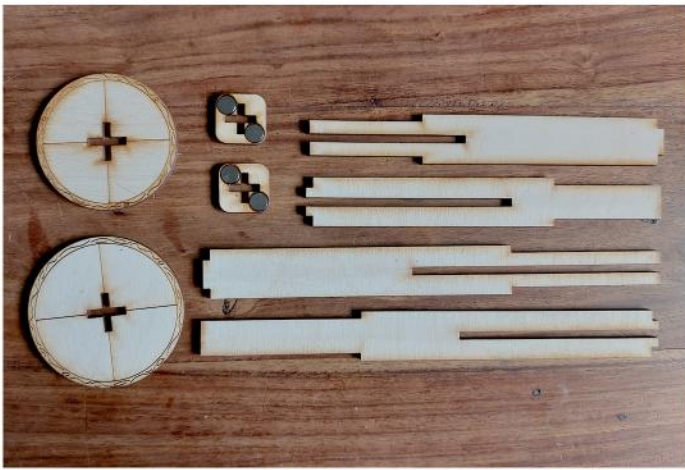


16) Firstly, ensure the marks on the rudder line up with the marks on the wall panel. There is only one orientation where they line up. Next, apply a little glue to the tab on the rudder and glue it into place as shown above.



17) Next, glue the magnetic panels in place with the magnets facing away from the wall panel. The wider magnetic panel should be fit on top and the narrow one on the bottom as shown above.

Before gluing any magnetic panel, please ensure you have checked them against their opposite panel to make sure they are the correct orientation and glue facing outward.



18) Layout of the parts needed to assemble the masts of the ship. Repeat following steps on both the large and small masts.



19) Glue and slide the two main sections of the mast together, then glue on the crow's nest panel with the texture facing upwards and finally glue on the base panel ensuring the magnets are facing downwards.



20) Layout of parts needed to assemble the Pirate ship anchor.



21) apply a small amount of glue to the tabs of both the anchor arms and slide them into the square hole on the main anchor body as shown above.

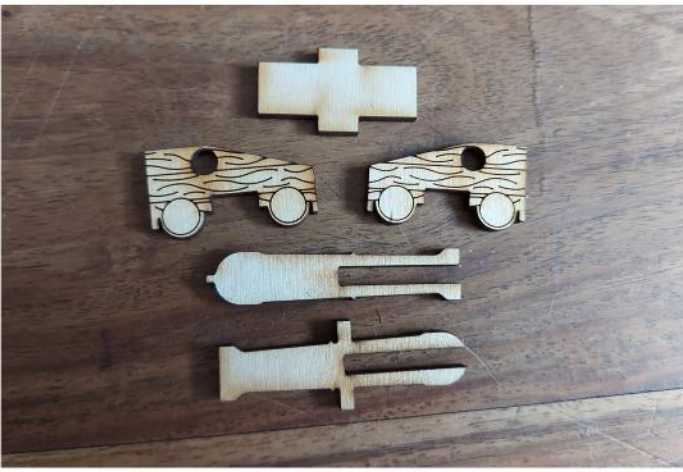


22) Layout of all the parts needed for the Pirate ship plank.



23) Assemble the plank as shown above, apply glue to both side clips, ensure they are facing the right directions (towards the deck) before gluing in place.

Before gluing any magnetic panel, please ensure you have checked them against their opposite panel to make sure they are the correct orientation and glue facing outward.



24) Layout all of the cannon parts as shown above, you will need to repeat this for all 4 cannons.



25) Glue and slide the two main sections of the cannon together as shown above. One will have two tabs which come out from the middle and the other will be smooth.



26) After the cannon pieces are glued together, slide the side piece over the tabs in the whole provided making sure the texture is facing outwards as shown above.



27) Then, apply a small amount of glue to the edges of the + shaped base panel and use it to secure the textured side pieces in place. Repeat this 4 more times.

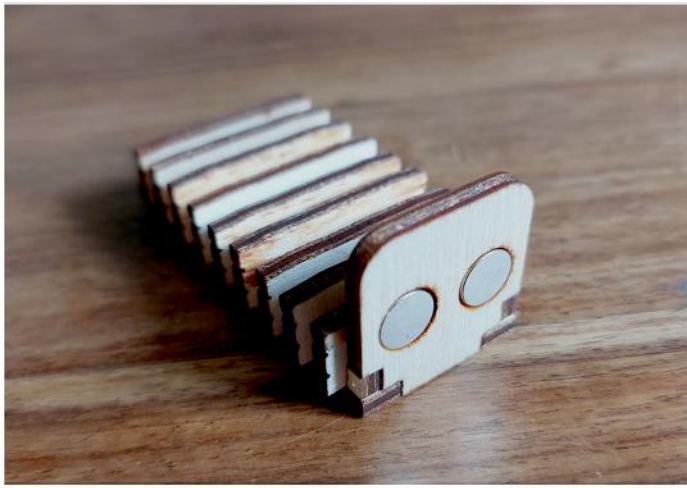


28) Layout of all the parts needed to assemble the lower deck staircase. x1 Back wall panel, x2 Stair side panels, x1 magnetic base panel, x9 stair panels.



29) To start, glue the 2 stair side panels onto the back wall panel. Once done, glue the tabs of each stair panel and push them into place. Make sure the stair texture is facing up towards the flat edge of the back wall panel.

Before gluing any magnetic panel, please ensure you have checked them against their opposite panel to make sure they are the correct orientation and glue facing outward.



32) Once the stair panels are in place, apply a small amount of glue to the tab on the magnetic panel. You then place the panel into the provided notch on the back wall panel as shown above.



With the lower deck staircase in place, you now have a fully complete merchant ship ready for your next adventure.
